HOME HEALTH SCREENING: One of the most important aspects of our return to campus will be the **home health screening**. If students arrive on campus with any of these symptoms, we have been directed to contact parents and/or guardians to come pick their child up from school. **Students can return to school 3 days after symptoms resolve:**

- Fever 100.4 or higher in the last 24 hours

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills/unexplained fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headaches
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell
